

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:

To operate a line truck or other motorized equipment in a safe manner in the course of line crew activities; to keep the truck in good operating condition and to report any mechanical defects; to keep the truck clean and the equipment and tools in an orderly manner; to assist the line crew, under the supervision of the Chief Lineman; perform other work as required.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED:

Works under the supervision of the Chief Linemen or other designated supervisor.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Ability to operate any of the motorized equipment in a safe and efficient manner; some knowledge of materials, procedures and practices used in line maintenance work; ability to do heavy physical labor under extreme weather conditions; ability to follow instructions; dependability; ability to work effectively with others.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduate of high school, trade school or the equivalent in experience and training, plus two (2) years employment involving motor equipment or line work. Must possess at least; a Class 2 Driver's License (Class B Commercial Driver's License) or be able to procure same prior to hiring.
