Dear Wallingford Residents and Community Members,

The Town of Wallingford Health Department and other local agencies are partnering with Hartford Healthcare to offer **walk-in (no appointment needed)** Covid-19 booster vaccination. At this time, booster doses will be made available to the public meeting the criteria listed below determined by the FDA and CDC starting on September 29, 2021. An individual would be eligible for a booster dose if 65+ years of age or immunocompromised starting 6 months after receiving their **second dose of Pfizer-BioNTech.**

Also, available at the listed walk-in clinics will be Johnson & Johnson vaccine as supply allows in addition to Pfizer-BioNTech for 1st or 2nd doses.

Individuals who received Moderna and J&J/Janssen COVID-19 vaccine, preliminary approval from the FDA has been obtained. CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) are meeting this week to provide final approval and guidance. Once that is obtained, both Moderna and Johnson and Johnson will be available at the above clinic dates for booster vaccination.
