INSPECTOR – WATER AND SANITARY SEWER

\$65,669 - \$84,027 (Annually)

General Statement of Duties: This is responsible inspection work involving installation or repair of water and sewer lines. Work involves responsibility for inspecting water and sewer mains and connections and related construction to insure compliance to codes and specification. Duties include reviewing plans for future water and sewer lines, instructing contractors on municipal requirements, inspecting installations and conducting tests of completed projects. This position also has the responsibility for making technical decisions in the field. The work requires that the employee have considerable skill, knowledge and ability in the practices and principles of water and sewer installations.

Examples of Duties: Inspects contractor's work on lateral and main water and sewer lines as well as individual building connections to insure compliance with codes, plans and specification. Locates buried water and sanitary sewer appurtenances using detection equipment, division records, and surveyor's transit and taping equipment and advises contractors where to dig to locate wyes and laterals which were originally installed for specific properties. Observes hydrostatic and air tests of all water and sewer lines to be accepted by the town. Performs dye tests. Flushes water mains and samples systems. Reviews plans for future water and sewer lines and prepares maps as needed, interprets blueprints, pertinent deeds and ordinances, issues water and sewer permits. Responds to questions pertaining to sewer and water construction requirements, sewer back ups, low water pressure, etc., from engineers, contractors, attorneys and the general public. Compiles reports, maintains files, and prepares as-built sketches of completed work. Performs related work as required.

Supervision Received: Works under the general supervision of the Senior Engineer for Water & Sewer.

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities: Considerable knowledge of a variety of sewer and water installation projects and the applicable codes, specifications and contract provisions. Considerable ability to interpret blueprints, plans, specifications and contracts and to determine contractors' compliance with same. Good ability to compile concise reports, and draw sketches of completed work. Considerable ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with superiors, associates, other town government departments and agencies, outside contractors, attorneys and the general public.

Qualifications: A high school or trade school diploma or the equivalent, plus two years of progressively responsible utility construction experience, or an equivalent combination of education and qualifying experience substituting on a year-for-year basis.

Special Requirements: P7 construction license from State of Connecticut, or obtain the license within one (1) year of appointment. Must possess and maintain a valid State of Connecticut Motor Vehicle Operator's License.

Fringe Benefits: Excellent Health Insurance Packages, Group Life Insurance, Pension Plan, Paid Holidays, Paid Vacations, Paid Sick Leave.
