
What You Need To Know About Measles



- Measles can cause serious health complications especially in children younger than 5 years of age.
 - Symptoms of measles can include:
 - o High fever
 - o Cough
 - o Runny nose
 - o Red, watery eyes
 - o Rash (3-5 days after symptoms begin)
- Measles is VERY contagious.
 - Measles spreads through air when an infected person coughs or sneezes.
 - One person can infect up to 9-10 people around them if they are not protected.
 - An infected person can spread measles to others even before knowing they have measles
- The best protection against the measles is the Measles-Mumps-Rubella (MMR) Vaccine.
 - Your child needs two doses of MMR vaccine for best protection:
 - o The first dose at 12 through 15 months of age
 - The second dose at 4 through 6 years of age
