## **Arrest made in 2009 Home Invasion/Robbery**

On October 9, 2009 the Wallingford Police Department investigated a home invasion/robbery on Saddlebrook Drive. During the incident, an 18-year-old male resident was attacked and restrained by four intruders. The four assailants were inside the residence for approximately 20 minutes and stole a large amount of currency as well as jewelry and electronics. Forensic evidence from the crime scene was sent to the state laboratory for analysis.

In October 2013, one of the four assailants was identified through DNA evidence as Victor Miguel Siguencia Lozano (04/15/1974), aka Miguel Lozano Altamiran. Wallingford Police obtained an arrest warrant for Lozano.

After the identification, detectives learned Lozano was arrested in 2010 by the Branford and Wethersfield Police Department's for similar type incidents as the one occurring in Wallingford. Lozano was convicted of these incidents and sentenced to serve jail time. In April 2013 after he served jail time, Lozano was released to the Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) and subsequently deported to Ecuador.

In September 2020, the Wallingford Police Department was notified by the United States Marshal Service that they had taken Lozano into custody in the State of Texas. Lozano was held for extradition back to Connecticut at the Harris County Detention Center in Houston, Texas.

Wallingford Police Detectives traveled to Texas and took custody of Lozano. Lozano was transported back to Connecticut to face charges from the 2009 incident. He was charged with Home Invasion, Robbery 1<sup>st</sup> degree, Burglary 1<sup>st</sup> degree, Larceny 1<sup>st</sup> degree, Unlawful restraint 1<sup>st</sup> degree, and conspiracy to all the above charges. He is currently in custody of the Connecticut Department of Corrections and is being held on a \$250,000.00 bond. Lozano is scheduled to appear at Meriden Superior Court on October 6<sup>th</sup>.
