The Second Half Taxes & Motor Vehicle Supplemental Bills are Due January 1, 2022
FINAL DATE FOR AN ON TIME PAYMENT IS FEBRUARY 1, 2022

The second half installment of Real Estate, Personal Property taxes and the Supplemental Motor Vehicle tax on the Grand List of October 1, 2020 is due January 1, 2022, and payable on February 1, 2022.

We do not mail another bill for the second installment.

Delinquent motor vehicle taxes shall be paid only by Cash, Bank Check, or Money Order, if you require a release to register a motor vehicle.

Failure to receive a tax bill does not invalidate the tax and respective penalties should the account become delinquent. If you have purchased property you may need to contact the previous owner, your attorney, or the Town to procure the bill, or to determine the amount due.

If you pay your taxes by check, it is your responsibility to make sure your check has cleared. The Tax Office cannot be responsible for lost mail.

Checks in payment of property taxes which have been returned by the bank shall be subject to a thirty-five (\$35.00) handling fee.

Unpaid taxes will be considered delinquent as of February 2, 2022. On that date, interest will be charged from the original due date of January 1, 2022. Interest is charged at a rate of 18% per year in accordance with the provisions of C.G.S. Sec. 12-146.

Payments may be made in person between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday at 45 So. Main St, Room 209. (**Noon hour included**) You may also use the “Payment” slot on the Prince Street side of the Town Hall next to the sliding glass doors.

After authorization of your payment, you will be given a confirmation number to keep for your records. A fee will be charged for this service.
