Dear Wallingford Residents and Community Members,

Listed below are the current locations within the Town of Wallingford offering Covid-19 vaccination. Over the coming weeks more information will be made available from the FDA and CDC regarding the Covid-19 booster doses. At this time, booster doses will be made available to the public starting on September 20, 2021. An individual would be eligible for a booster dose, starting 8 months after receiving their second dose of an mRNA vaccine (either Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna).

Individuals who received a J&J/Janssen COVID-19 vaccine, it is likely a booster dose will be necessary. J&J/Janssen vaccine was not administered in the United States until 70 days after the first mRNA vaccine doses (Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna). The data needed to make a decision regarding booster doses is not available at this time. The data is expected in the coming weeks and will be evaluated as to the booster schedule for J&J/Janssen vaccine. These timelines are subject to authorization by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration and recommendation by CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP).
