WATER CUSTOMERS

The Water Division will begin its annual water main flushing program on a Monday through Friday schedule between the hours of 7:30 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.

This flushing program will remove harmless deposits of accumulated rust and sediment and is necessary in order to improve and maintain water quality.

The areas to be flushed **beginning Monday, April 5, 2021**, will be the following:

Zone 1: South Airline Rd., Woodhouse Ave., Quigley Rd., Long Hill Rd., Saw Mill Dr., and all other streets in these areas.

Zone 2: Center St., East Main St., Kinsland Ave., Cooper Ave., Durham Rd., Sunrise Cir., Doris St., and all other streets in these areas.

Zone 3: Farm Hill Rd., Grieb Rd., Leigus Rd., Fairlawn Dr., Fieldstone Farms, Mapleview Rd., Old Durham Rd., Jobs Rd., Old/New Rock Hill Rd., Burke Heights Dr., Shetland Dr., No. Airline Rd., and all other streets in these areas.

Zone 4: No. Farms Rd., Fairfield Blvd., Barnes Rd., Northrop Rd., Research Pkwy., Carpenter La., and all other streets in these areas.

Zone 5: Tower Dr., Sterling Dr., Enterprise Dr., Barnes Ind. Rd. North., Barnes Rd., Alexander Dr., and all other streets in these areas.

Flushing of Zones 1 through 5 should take about six weeks.

Important: Please check the condition of the water before use, since discoloration of the water and lowered pressures may occur during flushing.
