WATER CUSTOMERS

The Water Division will continue its annual water main flushing program and will be flushing on a Monday through Friday schedule between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.

This flushing program will remove harmless deposits of accumulated rust and sediment and is necessary in order to improve and maintain water quality.

The areas to be flushed beginning Monday, September 28, 2020, will be the following:

Zone 8: Highland Avenue, Ridgewood Rd., Ridgecrest Rd., Ridgefield Rd., Ridgetop Rd., Parker Farms Rd., Mohawk Dr., Brookview Dr., Ridgenoll Rd., Wayne Rd., Deme Rd., and all other streets in these areas.

Zone 9: Cheshire Rd., Gaylord Farm Rd., Cheshire Crossing, Ashlar Village, Whiffletree Lane, Montowese Trail, Schoolhouse Rd., Cook Hill Rd., Broadview Dr., Autumn Leaves Rd., and all other streets in these areas.

Zone 10: Pierson Dr., Sharon Dr., Terrell Farms, Highland Ave., Buttonwood Cir., Edgewood Cir., and all other streets in these areas.

Flushing of these areas should take about seven weeks.

Important: Please check the condition of the water before use, since discoloration of the water and lowered pressures may occur during flushing.

This notice will also be carried by Government Access Channel 20 on Comcast Xfinity or Position 99 on Frontier TV and the Wallingford Town website (www.town.wallingford.ct.us at "News/Announcements" of "Water Main Flushing Program") and will be updated as necessary.
