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1. The purpose of the Wallingford Electric Division's (WED's) Renewable Energy Policy is to enable the customers billed on the WED's Municipal Service Rates 8 and 9 to access available funds intended to support the installation of renewable resources (as defined in Connecticut General Statute 16-1).
2. Interconnection Applications received by the WED's Engineering Department for residential renewable energy projects by February 1, 2020 will be grandfathered for incentive eligibility consideration.
3. Any renewable energy funding available through this Policy shall be on a first come, first served basis, subject to the availability of funds.
4. The WED's Renewable Energy Conservation Policy is administered with the assistance of the Connecticut Green Bank ("CGB").
5. For any project approved via this Policy, the WED shall provide financial incentives based on guidance provided by the CGB.
6. Customers who accept an incentive payment for their project(s) as provided by this policy shall agree any capacity-related credits or payments that the project(s) may be eligible to receive shall be fully assigned to the WED or its designee.
7. The WED reserves the right to consider, as eligible for an incentive payment, any renewable energy project evaluated based on the guidelines of the appropriate CGB program then in effect.
8. The WED's renewable energy incentive programs are funded from the WED's share of ISO-NE forward capacity market proceeds (ISO-NE is the abbreviation used for the Independent System Operator of New England, the regional entity responsible for the operation of the electric bulk power system).
