Firework Island Raceway Bridge

Rob brought in an aerial map of the Fireworks Island raceway / pedestrian bridge and the Yalesville On The Green. He discussed the outline of the 12-foot wide easement that will be for future ADA-compliant trail construction. Rob also pointed out the temporary construction easement area on the map.

There are other potential routes for the routing the QRLT across the raceway and through the condo parking lot. This could make part of the construction of the bridge / Main Street connector easier and potentially less expensive.

Rob also sent a letter to the Friends of the Linear Trail requesting an introduction and discussion about potential QRLT topics.
