# MONTHLY CONFIRMED CASE TOTALS

- 544 tested positive for Covid-19
- 228 Nursing Home cases – 42%
- 316 Community Cases – 58%
  
- June - 24 Confirmed Cases (23 Community) (1 Nursing Home)
- July - 18 Confirmed Cases (18 Community)
- August – 14 Confirmed Cases – (14 Community)
- September – 17 Confirmed Cases (16 Community and 1 Nursing Home)



# TESTING RESULTS

- Over entire pandemic 9,679 individuals were tested in the Town of Wallingford
- 21% of Total population tested
- 1.19% of total population tested positive for Covid-19
- 21,157 tests conducted were negative (multiple tests per person)



# 7-DAY ROLLING AVERAGE

- 7- day rolling average for the Town of Wallingford (45,000) currently 1.0 cases per day for the week ending on September 21<sup>th</sup> . If based on a population of 100,000 (2.0)
- New Haven County 7- day rolling average 3.0 (low)
- 7- day rolling average at peak of community cases in April 4.35 cases per day based on a population of 45,000.



# LONG TERM CARE FACILITIES COMPARED TO COMMUNITY BASED CONFIRMED COVID-19 FATALITIES

- 70 Total Fatalities
- 68 Long Term Care facilities
- 2 Community
- No fatalities reported since week of July 9th



# CONTACT TRACING

- Contact Tracing conducted monitoring 10 individuals with 13 contacts for a 10-day window as of September 21<sup>th</sup>.
- Utilizing Contact CT Microsoft System.
